Step 1


Click on the “ACCESS SIRC COURSES” button from the SIRC Courses landing page.





You can add some basic contact information by filling in the optional fields, then click on the “Next” button.





Step 5



Step 6

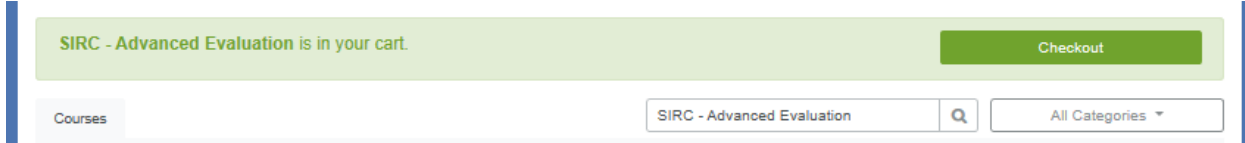

Step 7

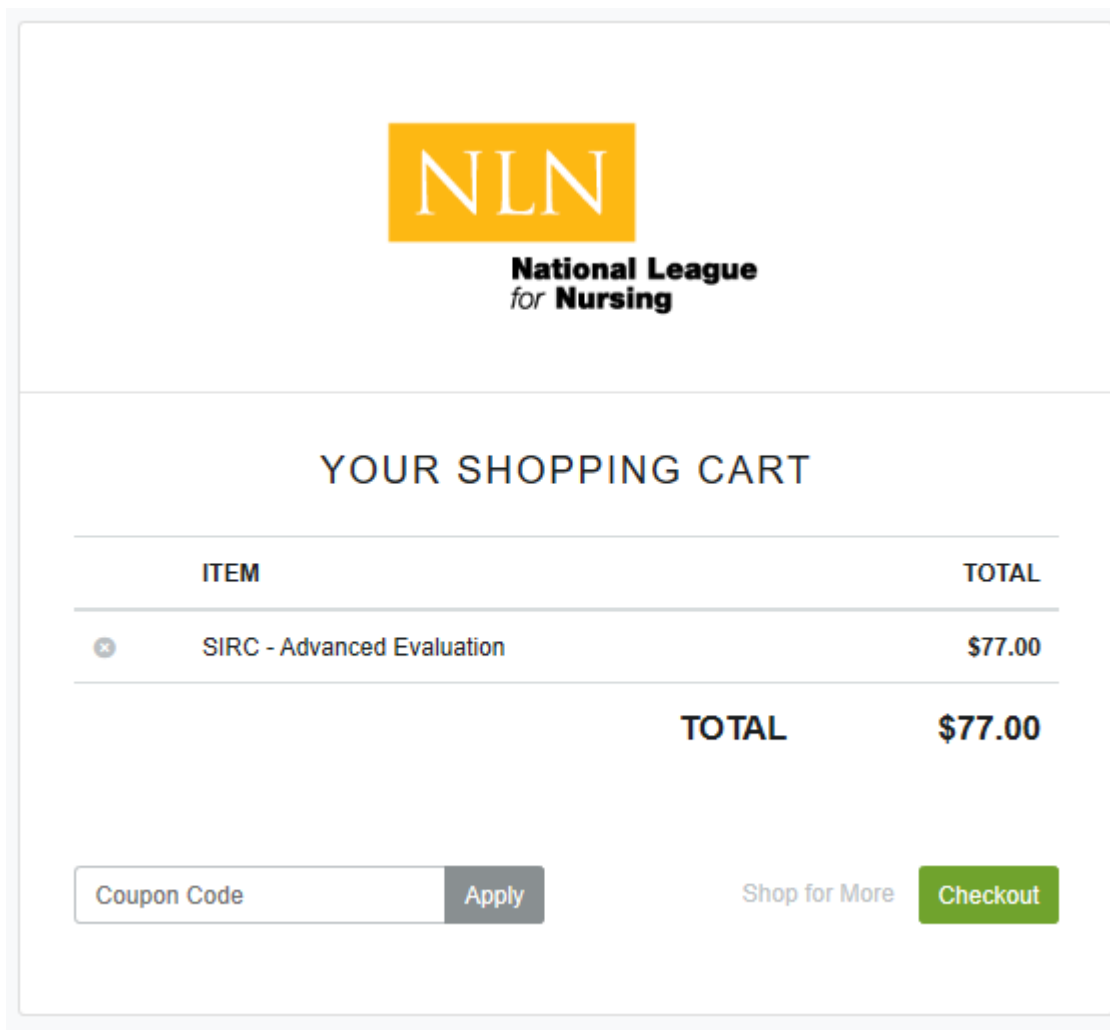
Once you are ready, click on the green “Checkout” button.

If you would like to add more courses to your cart, you can click on the gray “Shop for More” button.

- If you have a Coupon Code, enter it and click on the grey “Apply” button, then click on the “Submit” button. Please note that a Coupon Code for the SIRC bundle will only work for the “SIRC – All Course Bundle” and not for individual courses.
- If you are paying with a credit card, click on the green “Checkout” button and follow the checkout process on the payment screen.
